ABOUT US






TOURNAMENTS


MIDWEEK SCRIMMAGE

PRACTICES

Our goal is to be a one stop shop for our players by creating a competitive and encouraging environment so our athletes can push each other to be better.

Open Facility: You ask, we help and you get what you put into it. Come as often or as little as you'd like. This time is allocated for the player that wants to get better. Hitting and pitching time with individualized programs written for the athlete. The focus is on individual player development. As many sessions as you'd like, free of charge.

Team Practices: Team Practices are not mandatory, but highly encouraged. We dive into situations, how to's of the game, and build baseball IQ.


Live Simulations: We make sure players are ready for their high school seasons. These are pitcher vs. hitter sessions created to be as game-like and competitive as possible.

SPONSORSHIPS


Shockers Baseball offers individual sponsorships to assist with the cost of tuition. After a roster invite has been accepted and the commitment fee is paid, players and their families will have the opportunity to ask local businesses to "sponsor" their upcoming season.






NEXT STEPS

What happens after I make the team?

- Upper Hand: Each family of the player selected to the team will receive an invite to UpperHand, the scheduling software used by State Line Shockers Baseball. From there you will set up your account or login to your existing account. Through the app you will be able to view the facility's schedule and all necessary news regarding the program. This account will be necessary to pay online, schedule lessons, clinics, or camps, and to redeem any benefit afforded by the organization.
- GameChanger: Each family of the player selected to a team will receive an invite to GameChanger, the team home for any game schedules, stats, and communication efforts.
- GroupMe: Each player will receive an invite to GroupMe. This will allow for direct communication between players and coaches regarding a wide range of information. If a player does not have a device they are able to use, accommodations will be made.
- Band (Optional): Each family will receive an invitation to post and view any photo taken and posted to the team's feed. This is a public page that anyone with the link is able to view.
- FieldLevel (Optional): Each player will have the chance to create their own free FieldLevel account. The app acts as a social media platform for recruiting. Once the player has an account, they join State Line Shockers Baseball and are added to the program's roster to be seen by any and all coaches that are connected with Coaches and/or are following the team's page.
